

Driving Instructions to EAA 471 Main Hangar, Abilene, TX

General

The main chapter hangar is referred to as “Hangar 3”. It is located on the northwest end of Abilene Regional Airport (KABI). The airport is located about 3 miles southeast from the center of the city of Abilene. The hangar can be accessed from its west side during Chapter events. Hangar coordinates are: 32.4276,-99.6877 (Copy & paste into your favorite map app to see exactly where the hangar is.)

Driving Directions

These directions will guide you from the intersection of **Loop 322 (Jake Roberts Fwy.)** and **Hwy 36**.

Take the Loop 322 east access road south. (This is a two-way road.) Drive for 0.4 mile and take a left turn. You’ll pass by several American Eagle Saabs parked on the left. You’ll see our **EAA 471** directional sign along with “FedEx” signs at the turn. You’ll then be on **Navajo Trail**. Follow Navajo Trail for about 200 yards, at which point you’ll see the TSTC aviation school on your left. Pull into the drive at the TSTC aviation school. You can park in the TSTC parking lot. **Hangar 3 is the next large building to the south and is between TSTC and the ‘Polasek’ hangar.**
